



SUMMER PROJECT

The goal of Summer Project is to provide intensive discipleship over the course of 6-weeks through national, local, and international ministry opportunities. Our commitment is to help train and equip each participant to grow in their understanding of who God is and how they can leverage their lives for his glory.



WHAT IS SUMMER PROJECT?

Six weeks of intentional and intensive discipleship and missional experience where students serve locally, nationally, and internationally. During Summer Project, students will spend one week serving in NYC, three weeks in Asheville, NC, and two weeks in Southeast Asia.



NYC & AVL



In NYC, students will have the opportunity to work alongside missionaries working among Bengali Speaking Muslims. Each morning, the missionary will train the students on Muslim beliefs, world view, and how to best engage them with the Gospel. During the afternoon, students will practice sharing the Gospel in local parks, restaurants, etc. If someone believes, they are connected to the local missionary to continue discipleship.



During the time in Asheville, students will get hands on training in a variety of topics from theological and practical life skills. These trainings are led by Biltmore Church staff. The trainings are Bible based and conversational with the goal of helping students wrestle through what the Bible teaches and how it applies to their lives. Students will also get local church experience through serving alongside ministries of Biltmore Church so they are better equipped to join, serve, and engage the local church for the rest of their lives.

Southeast Asia

In Southeast Asia, students will jump in with a missionary family and learn what it means to serve in an international context. Students will be staying with a Biltmore Church partner and serving alongside them in their work, church, and ministry in the city. The goal for the time in Southeast Asia is for students to consider what it would look like for them to leverage their time, talents, resources for the sake of the gospel reaching the nations

STEP 1: Apply

Upon a submitted application a student will need to interview with the college pastor for final approval and acceptance.



STEP 3: Fundraise

After a student is accepted into SP they can begin fundraising. We recommend doing this as soon as possible after acceptance.
